This person will serve as a strategic thought-partner and report directly to the Executive Director. The Director of Finance will play a critical role in partnering with the leadership team in strategic decision making and operations for the company to continue to enhance its quality programming and build capacity.

Responsibilities

- 1. Responsible for entire accounting system: Payroll, Accounts Payable, General Ledger and Financial Reporting Systems.
- 2. Responsible for ensuring accounting system is maintained in accordance with generally accepted standards of accounting, reporting and agency policy.
- 3. Responsible for preparing requests for funds as needed.
- 4. Responsible for preparing budget analysis as needed to ensure budget compliance.
- 5. Responsible for ensuring financial records and internal controls are maintained.
- 6. Responsible for ensuring all financial reporting requirements for the Agency and each funding source is adhered to (including filing with the Office of the NC Auditor).
- 7. Prepares, files, and publishes monthly financial reports for Board of Directors, Executive Director, Policy Council and Program Directors.
- 8. Maintain Agency chart of accounts & prepare/post adjusting entries to general ledger as needed.
- 9. Responsible for scheduling and assisting with agency's annual audit and submitting RFPs as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors.
- 10. Responsible for preparing annual indirect cost proposal and updating cost allocation plan as needed.
- 11. Responsible for knowledge of and adherence to 2 CFR Part 200 Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards
